Following the retirement of Mrs Claire Hough, applications are invited for the post of Head of Peterhouse Girls School w.e.f January 2025. This exciting opportunity for the right candidate will not only be to lead one of Zimbabwe's most prestigious girls' schools, but also to join the Peterhouse Group of Schools in this key leadership position.

Peterhouse is a group of three well-resourced independent schools situated on two magnificent sites near Marondera, 80 kilometres east of Harare on the main Mutare road. The three schools consist of approximately 1,200 pupils most of whom are from Zimbabwe. (Peterhouse Boys: 500 full boarders aged 12 – 18; Peterhouse Girls; 440 full boarders with a small number of day scholars aged 12 – 18 and Springvale House (co-ed), a Preparatory School with 200 weekly boarders and day scholars aged 5 – 12).

Peterhouse Girls is synonymous with outstanding levels of success in the academic, sporting and cultural arenas with girls, at all ages, achieving extraordinary success in a supportive and happy educational environment.

The successful applicant will be a graduate of a well-recognised university; have an outstanding track record in independent education and will understand the culture and commitment required in running a boarding school. Equally, they will be understanding and sympathetic to the Anglican traditions and ethos of Peterhouse.
